PREPARING FOR YOUR MOVE

Once you confirm your new location, contact Cortavo so we can prepare for it, too. We'll need at least 60 days' notice to prepare properly. Then, when it's time to move, we'll need two or three days to set up your IT at the new location (if cabling is required, it will take a bit more time). Once we know you're moving, there are three important steps in our process.

STEP 1

SITE SURVEY

We're here to make your move as simple as possible, and that begins with running a site survey of both your current and future locations. Here's what that means:



We'll inventory and document your current system.

This includes all your equipment, including laptops, desktops, phones, servers, monitors, docking stations and more.

That also allows us to see if additional cabling will be required at the new location and prepare for that.

STEP 2

RELOCATION COORDINATION

Once the site surveys are complete, we'll use that information to map out a customized plan to transfer your IT equipment and internet connection to the new location. Typically, network cabling and internet connection are overlooked activities when SMBs try to move their IT environments on their own. In fact, internet connection is the steepest challenge of the entire process as well as the lengthiest, as it depends on the internet service provider (ISP). 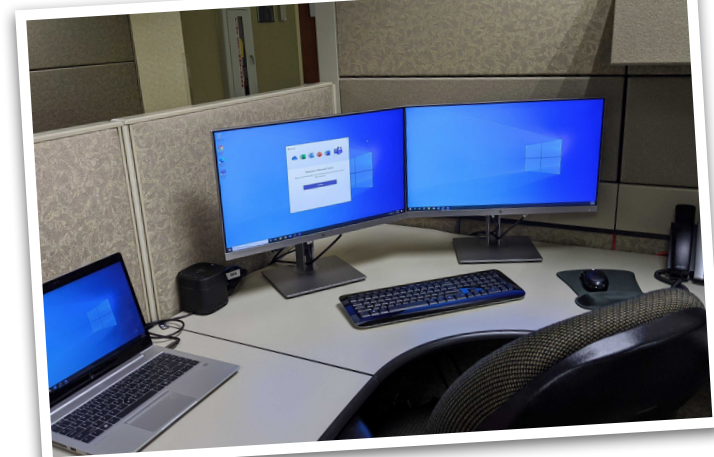
